## *File your Exemptions*

### **CONGRATULATIONS on the purchase of your new home!**

Upon the purchase of a new home, you are eligible to file for a Texas Homestead Exemption which may reduce the amount of property taxes you will be required to pay. The Homestead Exemption available through your local appraisal district helps you accomplish this by reducing a portion of the property taxes assessed against your home.

Contact the Appraisal District of the county in which you reside and request they send you the necessary forms for “Declaring Your Homestead” or download the form from the appraisal district website. Your appraisal district should automatically send an application form to all new property owners around the first of February.
